

## INVITATION TO TENDER

1. The Abia State Government through the **Ministry of Works** Implementation invites bidders to submit bid for the proposed **Reconstruction of Obohia Road (Phase 1) Aba South L.G.A.**  
All interested bidders must visit [www.abiaeprocurement.ab.gov.ng](http://www.abiaeprocurement.ab.gov.ng) to register their company and upload the following documents:
  - (i) Company's certificates of Incorporation with (CAC).
  - (ii) Company's registration certificate with the Abia State Ministry of Works.
  - (iii) Evidence of current tax clearance certificate.
2. Payment of non-refundable tender fee of one hundred naira (N150,000.00) only into Abia state IGR account through the E-procurement system. Payment link is available at the tender advertisement details page for this particular tender.

3. Login to your dashboard after registration and Click Tender Advertisement. You will see all published tenders on a table.  
On the table, Click on the particular Tender/project you wish to make payment for and it will open the Tender Advertisement Details page for that Tender/project. On the Tender Advertisement Details page for the selected Tender, you will see Payment link at the bottom. Click on the link and make online card payment.
4. Bid Documents in English will be obtained from the **Abia state e- Procurement system** ([www.abiaeprocurement.ab.gov.ng](http://www.abiaeprocurement.ab.gov.ng)) after completion of registration and Tender fee payment on the portal.
5. All bids will be submitted online using the E-Procurement system as mentioned above before 2<sup>nd</sup> February, 2020 at 1:00pm, local time. Late bids will not be accepted by the system.
6. Bids will be opened automatically by the E-Procurement system on the same day shortly after the close of tender on 2<sup>nd</sup> February, 2020 at 1:00pm, local time.
7. Any prospective bidder from their dashboard, may request clarification from the procuring entity.

8. The Abia State Bureau of Procurement is not bound to accept the lowest or any tender.
9. Bidding will be conducted in accordance with the Law governing Public Procurement.
