Invitation to Tender for Rehabilitation of Mbawsi Road from King Jerry Mortuary to Railway Crossing (2.5km).

INTRODUCTION

The Abia State Government, through the Ministry of Works, intends to carry out the Rehabilitation of Mbawsi Road from King Jerry Mortuary to Railway Crossing (2.5km).

In compliance with the provisions of the Abia State Procurement Law 2012, the Abia State Ministry of Works, on behalf of the Abia State Government, hereby invites interested, eligible and competent Contractors to bid for the **Rehabilitation of Mbawsi Road from King Jerry Mortuary to Railway Crossing (2.5km)**.

2.0 SCOPE OF THE WORK

The scope of the work will include the scarification of existing pavement before the Rehabilitation works of Mbawsi Road from King Jerry Mortuary to Railway Crossing (2.5km).

3.0 ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

Interested and competent companies are required to submit their verifiable evidence, profiles including but not limited to the following documents:

- a. Certificates of incorporation with cooperate Affairs commission
- b. Certified true copy of memorandum and articles of association
- c. Evidence of Registration with Abia state Works Registration Unit
- d. Company audited accounts for the last one (1) year
- e. Tax clearance for the last three (3) years
- f. Evidence of financial capability and banking support
- g. Company average annual turnover of not less than Five Million Naira (N5,000,000)
- h. Evidence of similar project executed (letter of award and completion certificate) at least three (3) in the last five (5) years.
- i. Verifiable evidence of company profile and technical qualification of key personnel registered with relevant professional bodies (COREN, CORBON, QSRBN, ARCON etc.)

- j. VAT registration and evidence of past remittance
- k. That the Company have fulfilled all obligations to pay taxes, pensions and social security contributions.
- l. A sworn affidavit certifying as follows:
 - i. That document submitted for pre- Qualifications exercise are not only genuine but correct
 - ii. That none of the directors of the company has been convicted by any Court of law
 - iii. That company is not Bankrupt
 - iv. That none of the officers of Abia state/Local Government is present or former Director of the company
- m. Any other relevant information that will help in determining the company's suitability for the work
- n. Any prospective bidder that does not possess any of the above documents need not to apply.

5.0 SUBMISSION OF THE TENDER DOCUMENT

- a. Technical and financial bids should be submitted in two different sealed envelopes and labeled "Technical" and "Financial Bid" respectively with the company's name indicated on one side of the envelopes and name of constituency and a lot number on the other side of the envelop.
- b. Both envelopes should be sealed in to one envelope also sealed and marked with the project name at the top right-hand corner and address to:

- c. Submission shall be made not later than Monday 2nd March, 2020 before 12 noon.
- d. All documents for submissions must be transmitted with a forwarding letter dully signed by company representative under the company's Letter Headed Paper bearing the CAC Registration Number (RC), Contact Address, Telephone Number (preferably GSM No.) and Email Address.
- e. The bid validity period should be 90 days from the deadline of the bid submission date.

6. OPENING OF BIDS

Technical and Financial bids received should be opened immediately after the deadline for submission by 12:00noon. at the Okpara conference Hall, Government House, Umuahia, Abia State.
