Pursuant to the provisions of Abia State Procurement Law 2012, the Ministry of Small and Medium Enterprises Development (MSMED), on behalf of the State Government, hereby invites interested, eligible and competent Contractors to bid for the underlisted projects.

2.0 SCOPE OF THE WORK

3.0 ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

Interested and competent SMEs are to register their company on the Abia State e-procurement portal (www.abiaeprocurement. ab.gov.ng) if they have not done so yet. Fill in company details and profile in all tabs under registration page in their dashboard, upload and submit required and verifiable company documents, profiles including but not limited to the following documents:

- i. Evidence of company's registration with the Corporate Affairs Commission (CAC) including form CAC 1.1 of CAC 2 and CAC 7. Business name is also acceptable for services.
- ii. Evidence of company's income tax clearance certificate) or personal income Tax Clearance certificate of all the partners in case of business name) for the last three (3) years (2018, 2019 and 2020) expiring on 31st December, 2021.
- iii. Evidence of contractors Registration with the Ministry of Works.
- iv. Evidence of participation of Abia MSMED/BPP training.
- v. Firms/company's registration with MSMED.
- vi. See MSMED One Stop Shop for assistance.

4.0 COLLECTION OF TENDER

- >> You will see Payment link at the bottom. Click on the link to initiate online card payment or bank payment.
- >> After payment, click "Purchased Bids" to process your purchased bids and submit.
- >> Tender documents are available in your dashboard for purchased bids.

5. SUBMISSION OF THE TENDER DOCUMENT

- a. Technical and financial bids shall be submitted through the e-Procurement system via economic operators' dashboard.
- b. Submission shall be made not later than Friday, 24th September 2021 before 2:00pm.
- c. All required bidding documents listed on the tender advert details page must be attached before submission of bid.

Technical and Financial bids received shall be opened electronically immediately after the deadline for submission by 2:00pm
